

# **Applicant Eligibility Criteria for Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant, Fiscal Year 2019–20**

Applicants must score a minimum of 5 points out of a possible 10 points to be eligible for funding.

If an applicant was funded in Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Cycle 1 (FW1) and also in a subsequent grant cycle Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Cycle 2 (FW2) or Cycle 3 (FW3), then eligibility will be scored based on the applicant's FW1 grant.

If an applicant was funded in FW2 and also in a subsequent grant cycle (FW3), then eligibility will be scored based on the applicant's FW2 grant.

## **Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Cycle 1 Applicants (FW1)**

**Applicant achieved the following as of April 1, 2020.**

### **5 Points – New Landfill Diversion**

- 5 Points: Project achieved 100% of its projected diversion.
- 4 Points: Project achieved 90–99% of its projected diversion.
- 3 Points: Project achieved 80–89% of its projected diversion.
- 2 Points: Project achieved 70–79% of its projected diversion.
- 1 Point: Project achieved 60–69% of its projected diversion.
- 0 Points: Project achieved less than 60% of its projected diversion.

### **5 Points – Expending Grant Funds**

- 5 Points: Applicant expended 100% of its grant award.
- 4 Points: Applicant expended at least 90–9% of its grant award.
- 3 Points: Applicant expended at least 80–89% of its grant award.
- 2 Points: Applicant expended at least 70–79% of its grant award.
- 1 Point: Applicant expended at least 60–69% of its grant award.
- 0 Points: Applicant expended less than 60% of its grant award.

## **Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Cycle 2 Applicants (FW2)**

**Applicant achieved the following as of February 29, 2020.** 5 Points – New Landfill Diversion

### **5 Points: Project achieved 63% or more of its projected diversion.**

- 4 Points: Project achieved 52–62% of its projected diversion.
- 3 Points: Project achieved 41–51% of its projected diversion.
- 2 Points: Project achieved 30–40% of its projected diversion.

Attachment 1: Applicant Eligibility Criteria for Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant Program, Fiscal Year 2019–20

- 1 Point: Project achieved 19–29% of its projected diversion.
- 0 Points: Project achieved less than 19% of its projected diversion.

### **5 Points – Expending Grant Funds**

- 5 Points: Applicant expended at least 63% of its grant award.
- 4 Points: Applicant expended at least 52–62% of its grant award.
- 3 Points: Applicant expended at least 41–51% of its grant award.
- 2 Points: Applicant expended at least 30–40% of its grant award.
- 1 Point: Applicant expended at least 19–29% of its grant award.
- 0 Points: Applicant expended less than 19% of its grant award.

## **Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Cycle 3 Applicants (FW3)**

Applicant achieved the following as of February 29, 2020.

### **5 Points – New Landfill Diversion**

- 5 Points: Project achieved 35% or more of its projected diversion.
- 4 Points: Project achieved 30–34% of its projected diversion.
- 3 Points: Project achieved 20–29% of its projected diversion.
- 2 Points: Project achieved 10–19% of its projected diversion.
- 1 Point: Project achieved 1–9% of its projected diversion.
- 0 Points: Project achieved less than 1% of its projected diversion.

### **5 Points – Expending Grant Funds**

- 5 Points: Applicant expended 35% of its grant award.
- 4 Points: Applicant expended at least 30–34% of its grant award.
- 3 Points: Applicant expended at least 20–29% of its grant award.
- 2 Points: Applicant expended at least 10–19% of its grant award.
- 1 Point: Applicant expended at least 1–9% of its grant award.
- 0 Points: Applicant expended less than 1% of its grant award.
